Training Committee Meeting Notes

1. Upcoming Training Opportunities co-sponsored by CIEMSD

- a. Difficult Airway Course Mercy \$100 tuition discount through CIEMSD and lunch provided by CIEMSD
 - i. Class has 14 registered
 - ii. Lee Richardson is the contact person for Mercy/CIEMSD
- b. EMS Instructor Development Conference, DMACC, April 6, 2013, Tuition \$49.00 CIEMSD will pay tuition for personnel from the nine county area
- c. Mercy is sponsoring the NAEMT EMS Safety Course on Saturday, April 13, 2013 from 0800-1700. Tuition is \$90 per student

2. NREMT Refresher, TJ Carroll

- a. Reviewed Final report for the 2013 class, approximately \$840 dollars remains outstanding from service billing. TJ Carroll was congratulated for excellent instructors at this year's programs.
- b. Confirmed dates for the 2014 class: Basic January 10-12, 2014. Advanced January 24-26, 2014
- c. Three locations are available for 2014, Mercy Hospital East Tower, the New DMACC Facility at Southridge Mall and the auditorium at Mary Greeley Medical Center. Committee members will finalize the location at the next meeting in April.
- d. Discussion on options that could be employed to reduce the registration fee were discussed by the group:
 - i. Reduce the overall registration fee
 - ii. Reduce the registration fee tied to an early registration cutoff 60 days prior
 - iii. Reduce the registration fee and not provide lunch
 - iv. Develop a sponsorship program for students, ie: instructors who teach for free would be able to sponsor students from a service

Significant discussion was held on each option. While the intent is not to be profitable, it does help offset the cost of other programs sponsored by the committee and CIEMSD. Committee members are encouraged to consider the options discussed and be prepared to finalize them at our April Meeting.
