**Why only one weekend this year?** The CIEMSD Training Committee has converted to the NREMT's National Continued Competency Program (NCCP) format. The model contains three components, a national component, a local or state component, and an individual component. To renew your NREMT, the NCCP requires:

Level	National	State/Local	Individual	Total Hours
Paramedic	30	15	15	60
AEMT	25	12.5	12.5	50
EMT	20	10	10	40

Completing the 2019 Refresher shall provide the following hours of National Continued Competencies:

**Paramedic - 25 hours/AEMT - 25 hours/EMT - 20 hours**

- ⇒ *EMT's will receive an additional 5 hours that may be utilized toward State/Local or Individual components*
- ⇒ *Paramedics will be provided with an additional 5 hours of National content that shall be offered through distributive education via webinar, dates to be determined. Information will be provided at the refresher program to participants.*

To complete your NREMT renewal you will still need to complete the balance of the State/Local and Individual hours required by NREMT. This is considered flexible content in Iowa and you may use any state CEH or locally mandated training.
